New south stair to renovated lobby



What's happening and how will I get around?

During construction:

- The Red Line will be shut down at times between North Quincy and Braintree Stations.
- Wollaston Station will be closed and trains will not stop at the station.
- **Free bus shuttles will provide connecting service during these times.**

Now - January 25, 2017*
Sundays through Thursdays
9 p.m. to closing

And on weekends

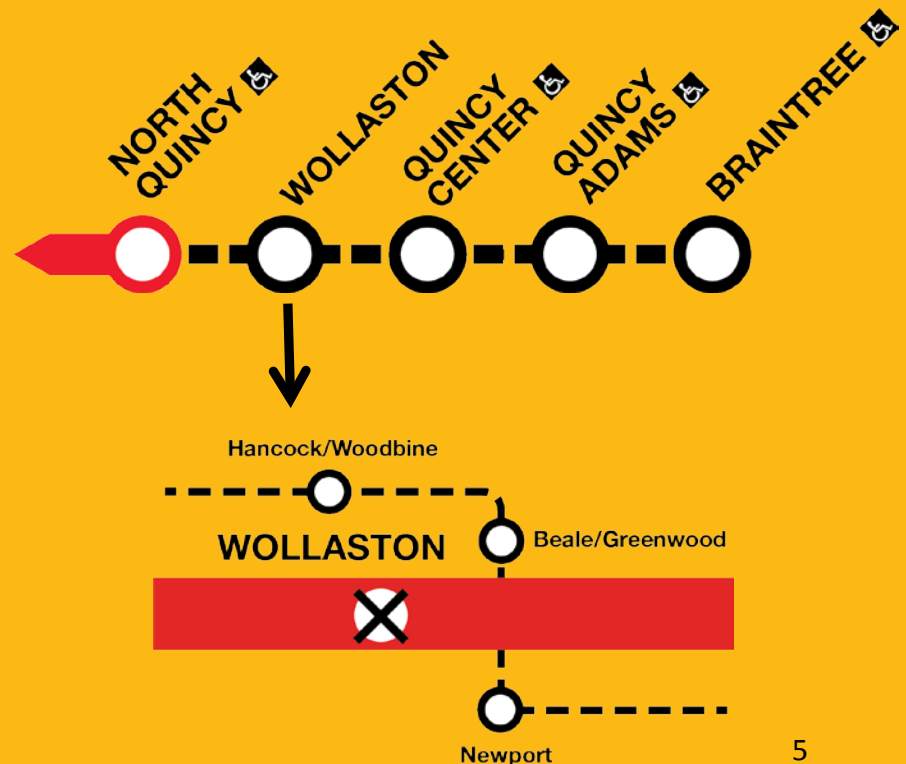
January 20 – April 22, 2017**

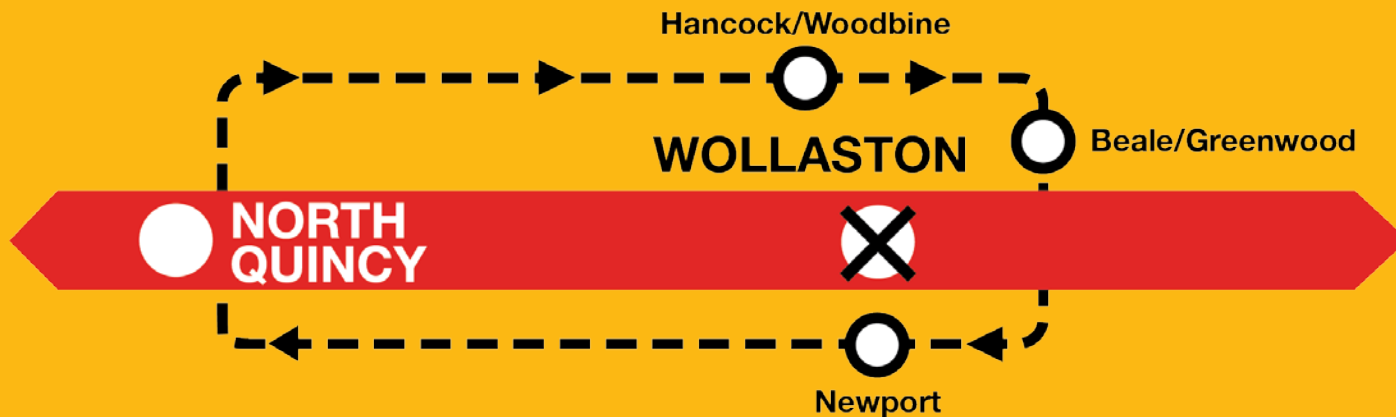

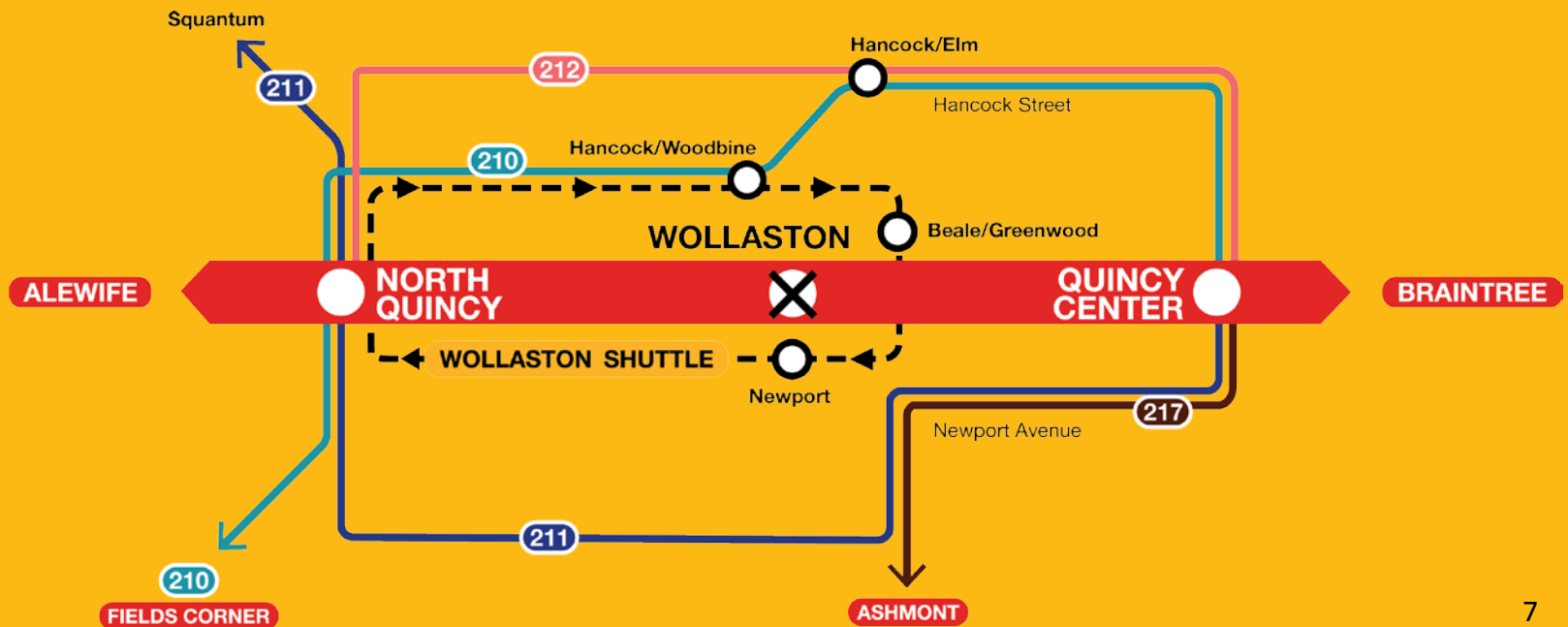

Getting to Quincy Center and nearby stations

Bus routes 210, 211, 212 and 217 all connect Quincy Center and offer many stops along their routes. Please view a bus schedule and/or the neighborhood map handout to find a stop near you. (All are available now)



Why January?

- January 2 is the latest date the station can be closed for the contractor to be in compliance with the contract requirements.
- Due to the construction duration, work will be required during the winter months
- The sooner the work starts the sooner the work is done and the station can be reopened.
