The MBTA will host a public meeting to discuss station construction dates and information on service to and from Wollaston.

When? And how will it impact service?

Weeknight bus shuttles start November 13

In advance of Wollaston Station construction, accessible bus shuttles will replace Red Line service between North Quincy and Braintree Station from 9 pm to closing.

Wollaston Station closes on January 2, 2018

Wollaston Station will close for construction and trains will not stop at the station as of January 2, 2018.

Bus shuttles will provide service between Wollaston and North Quincy Station for approximately 20 months during construction.
