Rt. 128 Garage:

E-ZPass is being upgraded to improve reliability and customer experience.

When?

- Transition begins at 1am Friday October 28th

How?

- All vehicles entering the garage **must** take a ticket;
- E-ZPass will **no longer activate the gate** at the entrance.
- E-ZPass customers **must** pay at the exit gates by inserting the ticket at exit and press the “**E-ZPass**” button on the exit lane Kiosk.

Things to keep in mind:

- **Only E-ZPass Massachusetts accounts will be valid (E-ZPass MA).**
- In order to **enter the garage**, all customers must take a ticket at entry.
- In order to **exit the garage**, all customers must insert ticket and select payment method at exit.
- Customers who misplace their ticket must stop by the parking office on the 2nd level station lobby to obtain a replacement ticket in order to pay and exit the garage.
- Customers opting to pay cash or credit may continue to do so on the 2nd level station lobby parking kiosks

For vehicles staying in the garage overnight Thursday evening October 27th, you must take a ticket when entering the garage rather than use E-ZPass to enter the garage. In order to prevent accidental E-ZPass gate activation, please remove the transponder from the windshield and take an entry ticket.
